



Directions for Resurrection Eggs:

- 1. Print out this page. Print on cardstock, if possible. Use a paper trimmer or scissors to cut out these 12 cards. If you have a laminator, you can laminate them to make them sturdier.
- 2. Collect an egg carton and 12 plastic eggs. Write the number on the outside of each egg with a permanent marker.
- 4. Put the correct card in each plastic egg and snap shut. (Egg #11 can be left empty or have the card inside.)
- 5. Use page two to teach your children the Easter story. Next time, have your child tell you the Easter story!

Resurrection Eggs

1. Bible

The Bible tells us the Easter story. The story is in the books of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John.

2. Donkey

Jesus rode on a donkey into the city of Jerusalem. Luke 19:28-35

3. Cup and Bread

Jesus ate the Last Supper with his disciples. Matthew 26:26-29

4. Praying

Jesus prayed in the garden of Gethsemane. Matthew 26:36-40

5. Sword

The guards came to arrest Jesus. Matthew 26:47-50

6. Crown of Thorns

The soldiers put a crown of thorns on Jesus's head. Matthew 27:27-30

7. Cross

Jesus died on the cross. Matthew 27:50

8. Rock

A large stone was rolled in front of the tomb opening. Matthew 27:65-66

9. Three

Three days after Jesus had died, some women went to the tomb. Matthew 28:1-4

10. Angel

The rock had been rolled away and an angel of God was sitting on the stone. Matthew 28:1-4

11. Empty

Jesus wasn't in the tomb. Matthew 28:5-9

12. Risen

Jesus had risen from the dead and was alive. Matthew 28:5-9
